



## HOW TO GET TO THE SÁZAVSKÝ OSTROV CAMP

Your journey to Sázava Camp will depend on your starting point and chosen mode of transport. Here's an overview of all the options:

### BY CAR

If you're driving from Prague, the route is straightforward. Take the D1 motorway towards Brno, then exit at Exit 34 (Ostředek and Sázava). Follow Road 111, cross the bridge over the Sázava River, and turn right immediately after the bridge. From there, signs will guide you directly to the camp.

If you're coming from Brno, take the D1 motorway towards Prague and exit at Exit 41 (Šternov and Sázava). Continue on Road 126 to Sázava. After crossing the bridge, follow the signs to the camp.

### BY TRAIN

The town of Sázava lies on train route 212, connecting Čerčany, Sázava, Zruč nad Sázavou, and Světlá nad Sázavou. The closest train stops are Sázava zastávka and Sázava–Černé Budy, both located about 1 km from the Sázava Monastery.

Čerčany is a rail hub on the route from Benešov to Prague, while Světlá nad Sázavou serves as a hub for the Brno–Kolín–Prague line.

### BY BUS

Several bus routes pass through Sázava and stop near the monastery. From the Sázava – Klášterní stops, it's just a 250-meter walk to the monastery gate (approximately a 5-minute walk).

Specific routes include:

Sázava – Klášterní from Prague (Metro Line C, Háje station), Route 382.

Sázava – Klášterní from Kolín (train station), Route 421.

Sázava – Klášterní from Uhlířské Janovice (town square), Route 770.

Sázava – Klášterní from Benešov (terminal near the train station), Route 770.



Sázava – Klášterní from Kutná Hora (bus station, via Ždánice or Vyžlovka) with one transfer: Route 381 with a connection to Route 382 or 421.

### **BY BOAT**

For water sports enthusiasts, Sázava Camp is the perfect destination. You can start your journey from Týnec nad Sázavou or Čerčany. The Sázava River naturally leads you to Sázava, where the camp is located on the river's right bank, not far from the town center.

### **BY BIKE**

Cyclists will love this option! If you're starting in Prague, take cycle route no. 19, which leads directly to Sázava. The route passes through Jesenice and Jílové u Prahy before following the Sázava River into town. After crossing the bridge in Sázava, simply follow the signs to the camp.

The entire route is approximately 50 km long, offering a scenic ride through beautiful natural landscapes.
