



ATTRACTIVE PLACES NEAR THE SÁZAVSKÝ OSTROV CAMP

SÁZAVA MONASTERY

- A historic monastery founded by Saint Prokop in the 11th century, recognized as one of the major spiritual and cultural centers of medieval Europe.
- Guided tours are available, offering insights into its rich history and stunning architecture.

KONOPIŠTĚ CASTLE

- Originally a Gothic fortress, later transformed into a Renaissance and Baroque chateau.
- Famous as the final residence of Archduke Franz Ferdinand d'Este, whose assassination triggered World War I.
- The castle park and rose garden are perfect for leisurely walks.

POSÁZAVÍ PACIFIC RAILWAY

- A historic railway line running through the picturesque Sázava River valley, known for its scenic views and romantic atmosphere.
- Visitors can enjoy a train ride through tunnels and over viaducts, offering a unique experience.

ČESKÝ ŠTERNBERK CASTLE

- A Gothic castle dating back to the 13th century, considered one of the best-preserved castles in the Czech Republic.
